

## **PROSPECTUS**

## VII. ADMISSION DETAILS

Admissions are normally made in L.K.G. Application forms will be issued at the school Office during the first week of February. It is important that correct details are furnished in the application form. The application form must be carefully filled up and submitted to the School Office within seven days from the date of issue. The Photo Copies of the following certificates must be attached along with the application form.

- 1. **Pre- K.G** (a) Corporation / Municipal Birth Certificate
  - (b) Age:  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  Yrs. on 31 st July.
- **2.** L.K.G. (a) Corporation / Municipal Birth Certificate
  - (b) Community Certificate for ST.SC, Most Backward Classes.
  - (c) Age: 3 + on 31 st July.

## 3. U.K.G. to Std. IX

Admissions to these classes are made only as and when vacancies occur under the following conditions:

- 1. Written entrance examination in subjects (English, Maths, Science,
- 2. Photo copies of Birth Certificate, Community Certificates and attested marks of the Half-yearly Examination must be enclosed.
- 3. The originals of the above certificates must be brought at the time of interview.
- 4. For pupils seeking admissions the Transfer Certificates should be countersigned by the respective Inspecting Authorities.
- 5. A candidate seeking admission has to fill up the application form in which all the details should be given.
- 6. The school authorities have the right to reject any application before the entrance exam itself.
- 7. The list of selected Candidates will be displayed in the notice board. The prescribed fees for the selected candidates should be paid in full on or before the due date.
- 8. Admission can be refused to a candidate, who is overaged or underaged for the class to which admission is sought.
- 9. No other person except the one who signs the application form for admission and declaration will be entertained in the school to deal with the affairs of the pupil.

- 10. Application for a Transfer Certificate shall be made in writing to the Principal by the parents or Guardian of the pupil on or before the 3 f<sup>t</sup> March failing which the payment of fees mandatory for the next term becomes for receiving the T.C.
- 11. When an application of Transfer Certificate is made after a lapse of one year from the date on which the pupil actually left the school, a fine of Rs. 25/- will be charged for each year that has so lapsed.
- 12. No Certificates (of any kind) will be issued to anyone who is in arrears of fees.
- N.B: i) For Students seeking admissions, the Transfer Certificates should be countersigned by the respective inspecting authorities.
  - *ii)* Issue of application form is not a guarantee for admission.

Pupils for admissions must be accompanied by both the parent or guardians who must sign the prescribed admission form and pledge themselves to abide by the rules and regulations of the school.

If a parent wishes to withdraw the child from the school, he / she should submit a written application to the Principal. Transfer Certificate will be issued only if and when all the payments due to the school are made good. If a student is withdrawn in the middle of a term, the parent will be asked to pay the fees for the whole year.

Pupils are liable to be suspended or dismissed with the Transfer Certificate at any time of the year if their conduct is detrimental to the discipline of the school.

#### VIII.EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

- 1. Progress of the pupil is assessed by internal and external assessments.
- 2. Mid term and terminal exams are conducted at the end of which reports are sent to the Parents for their information and scrutiny on the academic performance of their children.
- 3. Parents are requested to take the necessary follow-up actions by meeting the Principal or the concerned subject teacher and follow their suggestions.
- 4. Pupils who absent themselves from the examination without valid reason will be considered as failed.
- 5. No re-exam will be considered for any absentee. In well deserving cases, marks of the year will be taken into account.
- 6. The Principal will be the final judge of the merit of each case.
- 7. Record of the pupils' marks may be maintained in the separate columns provided for each examination in the Handbook.
- 8. No appeal will be entertained once the results are announced after the annual examination.
- 9. If any pupil is found lacking the ability to cope with the workload of the next higher class, he or she will be allowed to repeat one more year in the same class. Even after spending two years in one class if a pupil remains unfit to take up the workload of the next higher class, Transfer Certificate will be sent along with the result.
- 10. Private tuitions are not allowed, on any account. Violations in this regard will result in dismissal.

- 11. Pupils should take all the tests and exams seriously.
- 12. A minimum attendance of 95% is also needed for promotion.
- 13. If a pupil is found copying in the examination he/ she will be suspended for 7 days and if he/ she is caught for a second time he/ she will be dismissed from the school.
- 14. No leave will be granted during examination days.
- 15. Normally after each examination the valued answer scripts will be distributed on the re-opening day after the vacation and progress cards will be issued as per dates mentioned in the calendar. The progress reports and the answer papers should be signed by the parent and be returned within the two days of the receipt of the same. Failure to return the same on the fixed date will result in disciplinary action.

## IX. LEAVE AND ATTENDANCE:

- 1. Attendance is compulsory on the reopening day of each term of the school.
- 2. No pupil is allowed to leave the school premises without the permission of the Principal.
- 3. Pupils may avail leave only with prior permission, except in unforeseen cases. In such an eventuality they are to ensure that the leave application reaches the office or the class teacher on the first day of absence.
- 4. Any pupil availing himself or herself of sick leave shall be required to produce a Medical Certificate.
- 5 In case of the absence of pupils of Stds. X, XI & XII parents should accompany their children when they come to the school and meet the Principal.
- 6 Absence without leave

- 5. Absence without leave and late coming shall be considered as a punishable offence. Habitual late comer shall not be allowed to attend school and will be severely dealt with.
- 6. Incase of unauthorized absence of 5 or more consecutive working days, without permission, the pupil will be marked 'LEFT'. He / She will not be readmitted as a matter of course.
- 7. Every student should have attendance not less than 80% of the working days in a school year, failing which, promotion to the next higher class will be affected.
- 8. Absence during tests and examinations will be viewed very seriously if prior permission is not obtained.
- 9. No pupil will be allowed to go home after entering the school premises even if he / she produces a leave application. A pupil will not be permitted to take leave for halfday unless the parent comes in person.

## X. MEDICAL INSPECTION:

School conducts periodical medical inspection. Follow up action is expected from the parents immediately on the advice of the doctor.

## XI. UNIFORM:

The prescribed school uniform should be worn on all working days. Every pupil is expected to have two sets of uniform. The uniform should be spotlessly clean and well ironed.

## Stds. VI to IX

White with dark grey stripes salvar with dark grey collar and border in the hand. Grey Khameez and overcoat. Black shoes, white socks and black ribbons.

White Khameez and Salvar (top & bottom) white over coat, white canvas shoes and white socks and white ribbons.

## Stds. X to XII

White with dark grey stripes salvar, Grey khameez and over coat. Black shoes with white socks and black ribbons.

## **WHITE UNIFORM**

White khameez and salvar (top & bottom). White over coat, white canvas shoes and white socks and white ribbons.

Uniform must be cleaned, hair well combed, nails well trimmed and shoes well polished. Non - compliance of these points are sufficient reasons to send the child back home during the school hours. Special attention of the parents is required on these matters.

- Note: 1) On all Fridays and during all the school functions all the pupils should wear white and White uniform clothes.
  - 2) On all Wednesdays and during all the Sports events all the pupils should wear the House uniform clothes.



### XII. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1. The School begins with Morning Assembly, everyday. Attendance is compulsory. Those who come late or those who have been absent on the previous day must bring the late attendance or leave record signed by their parents or guardians to be shown to the Principal. If a pupil exceeds more than five late attendance, suitable action will be taken by the school authorities.
- 2. Pupils should always be clean and well dressed, in complete School Uniform.
- 3. Pupils are responsible for the care of their personal belongings. It is not advisable to wear jewellery, ornaments, watches etc., to the school. The school Management takes no responsibility for their loss.
- 4. Pupils should take care of the School furniture, should not lean against the wall, leave the School campus clean and tidy. Damage done to the School property must be paid for at the discretion of the Principal.
- 5. No Pupil may leave the School Premises during the School hours without the permission of the Principal. Any person wishing to meet a Pupil or a Teacher in the premises should get the permission of school authority.
- 6. Pupils should at all times show respect and reverence to the school authorities and the staff. They should be gentle and polite to their companions.
- 7. Pupils should always remember that the name of the school depends on each one's good behaviour and that they are the real AMBASSADORS of the School. So their behaviour inside and outside the school should be excellent and praise worthy.
- 8. The bell before the assembly or class is a call to be obeyed promptly.



- 9. Going from one class to another should be done in silence.
- 10. Pupils are strictly forbidden to bring objectionable books, newspapers, novels and periodicals to the school.
- 11. English, which is the medium of instruction in this School should be used AT ALL TIMES in the School PREMISES.
- 12. Pupils are strictly forbidden to make any collection without explicit permission of the Principal.
- 13. Library books lost have to be compensated by the amount stipulated by the Principal.
- 14. No pupil will receive private correspondence through the School. Boys must have decent hair cut.
- 15. It is compulsory to be present on all important occasions such as re-opening day, closing day, school day, Sports day, Seminar days etc.,
- 16. No pupil will be allowed to attend the School with infectious diseases like chicken pox, mumps, measles etc. The Principal will decide whether the pupils is fit to attend the School or not. When a pupil is on sick leave for more than five days, a Doctor's Certificate must be produced.
- 17. Parents should see their children prepare homelessons properly and devote at least two hours in the morning and two hours in the evening to study.
- 18. The School cannot be held responsible for accidents small or serious to pupils during the school hours or Excursions.
- 19. Any correspondence addressed to pupil will be handed over to him only after the inspection of the Principal.
- 20. All pupils are responsible to the authorities for their behaviour inside and outside the School. Any

- objectionable behaviour outside reported to the School authorities, shall make the pupil liable to disciplinary action.
- 21. Insubordination, irregular attendance, habitual laziness, any kind of malpractice in the exam etc., are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of a pupil from the school.
- 22. Every pupil must have a copy of the School Handbook, which must be brought to the school daily.
- 23. The use of Cellular Phones or G.S.M. is strictly forbidden inside the School Campus.
- 24. No pupil is permitted to join any other association or sports club without the written permission of the Principal.
- 25. No pupil is allowed to pursue any other study out side the school. To appear for any examination outside the School, the written permission of the Principal is a must.

## **SPECIALITIES:**

We aim at high standard, discipline and character. It is a non-profit oriented institution. Talent search and Career guidance is given. Co-curricular activities, sports and hobbies are promoted.

Noise free atmosphere, good water and sanitation, proper building and facilities are provided. Only limited pupils are in each class room. Efficient, talented and qualified teachers care for the children. Religious harmony is promoted. Computer education is provided for all. SMART classes with inter - active Digi boards and digital content effective in teaching the Spoken English.

Our School trains the children in 'Spoken English' with a well equipped ultra-modern English Laboratory and an able trainer.

### XIII. LIBRARY AND READING ROOMS

- 1. Pupils of classes VI to XII are permitted to borrow only one book at a time.
- 2. The book must be returned with the due date, failing which a fine of Rs. 1/- per day will be collected.
- 3. In case of any damage to the book, the borrower should pay the full cost.
- 4. Transfer of books without proper entry is not permitted. The pupil in whose name the book is, will be held responsible for the return.
- 5. Books will be given in the library period to read and improve the language.

#### XIV. GAMES & EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Regular games are held form 3.30 4.30 p.m. on days specified for each class.
- 2. Attendance is compulsory for games.
- 3. Pupils who cannot play out door games are advised to play indoor games.
- 4. Associations and clubs are conducted to encourage participation on the part of the pupils.
- 5. Scouts and guides are given full training for Rajya Puraskar and Rashtrapathi Award.
- 6. Music and Dance offer challenging opportunities.
- 7. In order to develop leadership qualities and grow into balanced personalities pupils from Std IV upwards are divided into four houses.
- 8. Inter-House sports and competitions like debate, quiz, essay writing, music, dance, painting, etc. are conducted.
- 9. House Captains and Vice Captains are elected by the house members.
- 10. Opportunity is given to the pupils for doing social service.

## XV. REWARDS AND HONOURS:

School toppers in std XII and X will be granted cash prize. Prizes are awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> rank holders of all classes.
